Reports of the surveys of these ships during construction have been received from the Surveyors at Glasgow, but assignment of the class SA1 "For Service on the River Irrawaddy, Burma (limiting port seawards - Rangoon)" is being withheld pending receipt of reports of the satisfactory condition of each vessel on arrival at her destination.

I shall, therefore, be glad if you will arrange to carry out General Examinations in drydock on their arrival and ascertain that the ceiling in the hold spaces has been laid and fitting out for service completed before the ships are commissioned.

Your reports 8 and 9 in respect of these inspections are awaited, in due course.
