*Surveyed the* Steel Screw Steamer "SADIKLAR", 4286 tons gross  
of Istanbul, whilst lying afloat in the Bosphorous off Büyükdere  
on the 9th March 1955, for damage stated to have been caused  
by vessel ranging against the quay at Iskenderun on 22nd  
February 1955 due to a sudden storm  
*and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's  
Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all <sup>temporary</sup> repairs  
recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and  
that I have Recommended that she be continued as now classed  
without fresh record of survey, subject to vessel being again  
examined at the next drydocking.*

*being fit to carry her usual cargoes.*

Note:- The vessel's class is subject to any conditions at  
present attached being dealt with as previously recommended
