The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

The class is subject to rudderstock (twisted 1,48) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the next Special Survey.

SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 8,54.

The proposal to postpone the Special Survey for 12 months approved, provided the ship is submitted to a satisfactory General Examination afloat on her forthcoming arrival at Istanbul and is opened up and examined as for Special Survey and is found or placed in a satisfactory condition for the proposed postponement the G.E. to be supplemented by an examination in drydock in February, next; see letter dated 28.8.54.

The ISTANBUL Surveyor reports 8,54 a number of items generally examined for postponement of Special Survey. The Surveyor also states in his report that the general condition of the ship in his opinion merits the favourable consideration of the Committee for postponement of Special Survey until August, 1955, subject to the ship being found or placed in a satisfactory condition in drydock not later than the end of February, 1955.

The Surveyor has since been advised by letter dated 7.9.54 that in view of the ship's age it is considered that all the requirements of the Society's letter dated 28.8.54 should be complied with before postponement of the Special Survey can be considered by the Committee.

IT IS SUBMITTED ACTION be DEFERRED subject as above, pending receipt of Owners' intentions regarding the examination of the ship as for Special Survey now overdue.
