The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

The VENICE Surveyors report (4,58), this ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated and the SPECIAL SURVEY (D) due 10,58 commenced (principal portion).

On account of wear and tear repairs effected to upper deck plating, shell plating aft (p.s.) and No.5 D.B.tank etc.

The ship has been converted to oil fuel burning at this time in accordance with Rule requirements and approved plans.

The thicknesses of shell and deck plating as ascertained by drilling and reported by the Surveyors are as embodied in the report and together with the repairs now effected are considered satisfactory.

TO COMPLETE THE S.S. - Nos. 4, 5 & 6 D.B.tanks to be TESTED and Machinery space under platform to be EXAMINED.

SUBMITTED record of 'DS 3,58' be assigned the Notation of 'SS Ven. 3,58(Dr)' being WITHHELD for completion of Special Survey.

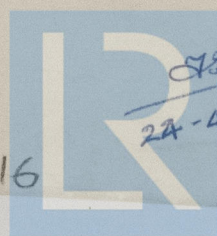
