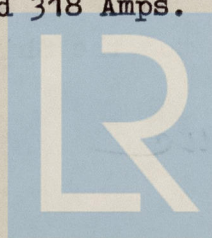
I have made survey of prime mover (steam engine) of Starbd Generator under working conditions.

The results of survey are:

1. The prime mover was repaired by the vessels engineers.
2. The prime mover has the new parts: cylinder block, cylinder cover, piston, piston rod, crosshead, crankpin bearing and other parts.
3. The new parts were manufactured by same firm, but not covered with Lloyd's Register of Shipping certificates.
4. At the time of the test the load was up to 220 Amps, which is the normal consumption of ship's equipment.
5. The inspection of the new installed parts after the test showed no defects.

The prime mover of the generator can operate continuously at full load, but not exceeding 220 Amps.

In respect of survey now hold the ship's class is confirmed providing the Generator is tested at rated load 318 Amps.

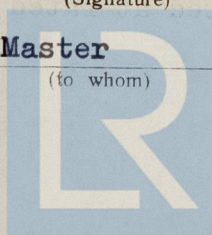
