
Dear Sir,

In reply to your Classing Letter of the 10th instant regarding the s.s. "WILLOWBANK", we beg to advise you that there are seven bulkheads extending to the upper deck, ceiling is laid on the inner bottom under the hatchways and a spare propeller was placed on board vessel at this port.

During survey it was observed that cargo battens require to be placed in order, the Class of the vessel being made subject accordingly, and we regret this omission from our report.
