With reference to my letter of the 3rd March, 1960 it is concluded this vessel is still laid up in Japan. I have, however, to point out that she will become due for Screwshaft Survey at the end of May next, and it is assumed the opportunity will be taken to deal with this inspection at the drydocking prior to proceeding to sea again. I shall be glad if you will bring this to the notice of the Owners and transmit to them the enclosed memorandum relating to screwshafts of 'Liberty' and 'near-Liberty' type vessels.
