The Report of the survey carried out by the Society's Adelaide Surveyors between the 4th and 11th ultimo, has now received the consideration of the Committee.

As a result of this inspection, the Committee have continued the vessel's class subject, inter alia, to deep tank wash plate etc., being specially examined and dealt with as necessary on the ship's arrival in Japan on completion of the present voyage, by the end of October, 1964, - deep tank not to be used for ballast meantime, and to permanent repairs to shell plates H.7, G.14 and 15 (starboard side from aft) by the end of January, 1965.

It is concluded that you will make the necessary arrangements in this respect.
