Burmeister & Wain's No.543, and with regard thereto I have to state that as freeboard is a condition of the class of this vessel, it will be necessary for the freeboards assigned by the Norwegian Authorities to be approved by the Committee of this Society.

I shall therefore be glad if you will forward a memorandum of the freeboards assigned by the Norwegian Authorities, including all the seasonal allowances, for the consideration of the Committee.

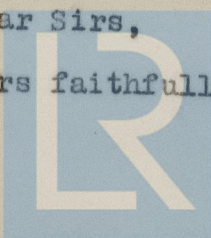
