EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR DOCKING AND DAMAGE.

Wear and Tear Repairs:- (ship stated to be experiencing excessive vibration).

Shell Approx 200 rivets renewed and a number of seams caulked.

Doublings fitted under hawse pipes P&S.

Bulkheads fracture on forward bhd. of (ss) settling tank, veed out and welded.

Securing of detached F.W. tank in way modified. Securing of S.W. tank (PS) also modified.

Damage 1:-stated sustained due to contact with tug (no name given) in River Schelde at 123 Buoy on 15-2-60.

Damage 1 Repairs:- Shell.(ps) F4 from forward, part cropped and renewed.

Shell.(ps) E3 & F3 faired in place.

3 frames in way faired in place.

Damage 2:-stated sustained due to ship grounding at Barnetts Wharf, Rochester, on 6th, 7th and 8th January 1960. On examination found: shell plates (ss) B5&B6 indented. (no repairs done at this time). It is recommended that this damage be repaired at the Owners' convenience being considered efficient meantime. To be recorded in the APP. to S.R.L. as

"Shell plates (ss) B5 & B6 indented".


