**Non-Propelled Dredgers  
"Amur" and "Ladoga."**

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 18th August, the contents of which have been noted.

It is concluded that the "Amur" is at Odessa. It is suggested that the class 100A1 "Dredger" "Black Sea Coasting Service" could be assigned for the "Amur", and in the case of the "Ladoga", the class 100A1 "Dredger" "Gulf of Amur Coasting Service" would be suitable.

It should be noted that the vessels should be generally examined on arrival in these areas, but as in previous cases - Arima Yard Nos. 850 - 859 - this examination could be waived.

An early reply will be appreciated, stating whether or not the above service limits are acceptable to the Owners.
