

This is to certify that the hull and machinery excluding dredging part of the Non-Propelled Dipper Dredger "AMUR" of Nakhodka, U.S.S.R. have been surveyed by us during construction and installation at Messrs. Hakodate Dock Co., Ltd., Hakodate, Japan (their Yard No.356) and were found, on the above date, to be in accordance with the approved plans and the Society's Rules, Regulations and requirements.

A report is being forwarded to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London recommending that this dredger be classed *100A1 "Dreger" "River & Inland Water service" with the notation "Longitudinal Framing".
