No Interim Certificates were issued as the Owners Agents could not be located, The Vessel managed to clear this port without Certificates. (The intricacies of shipping in Indonesia).

Certificates are not handed over to Owners or Agents without payment, in the case of small ships whose bona fides are not known.

This ship has cleared out leaving repair contractors, Dry Docks, etc, without payment. We are in the same boat, & not wishing to acquire further bad debts on our books, it was considered prudent to withhold Interim Certificates, & to forward the Reports Nos 6099, & to report the position to London.
