

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be retained as now classed without fresh record of survey, subject to the shell plating in the second strake below sheer in way of frames Nos.165 to 167, port side, being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the vessel's next drydocking.


