This tug was built in the U.K. for service at Ceylon and the class #100A1 "Tug" "For service within 10 miles of Ceylon Coast" was recommended WHEN a report has been received of its satisfactory condition on its arrival at Ceylon.

The Colombo Surveyor report (9.59) tug examined on slipway at Colombo and found in satisfactory condition.

IT IS THEREFORE SUBMITTED the tug is now eligible to be classed #100A1 "Tug" "For Service within 10 miles of Ceylon Coast" as previously recommended, with record of DS 9.59.
