CLASSING LETTER

11640 "ORSHA". This ship has to-day been classed +100A1 "Ice Class 3" together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

It is concluded that the intermediate shaft diameter is 460 millimetres diameter and not as reported, also that a barred speed range Noticeboard has been fitted to the 150 KVA diesel alternator set, but your confirmation is desired.

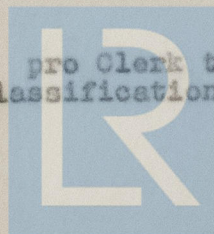
12321 "BABYLON". As recommended, except that assignment of the notation SS 12.63 has been deferred pending the renewal of 240 fathoms of worn chain cable.

12420 "GLEHPARK". As recommended, except that the machinery class has been continued subject as previously recorded to the main engine No.2 cylinder liner (Metalocked) being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary by 3.64, and to the main engine No.4 cylinder liner being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary by the end of 9.64.
