

Now Done - Two 12 inch cowl ventilators fitted on Upper Deck, one to Butcher's Shop P.S. and one to Dry Store Spaces S.S. in 'tween decks amidship, coamings 10'-3" high x .40" thick efficiently stayed to Boat Deck and fitted with wood plugs and canvas covers. ✓






