I am advised by the Society's Surveyor at Chittagong that he has been unable to obtain from you a definite proposal for the Annual Surveys of these Barges, which are now considerably overdue.

The Special Arrangement whereby Docking Surveys may be held at four yearly intervals (i.e. at the due date of each Special Survey), was approved on the understanding that an Annual Survey be held afloat.

As the maintenance of the Classification these Barges is dependent upon surveys being held in accordance with the Society's Requirements, I shall be glad to learn for the information of the Committee by what early and definite date each Barge will be submitted for survey afloat.

The Society's Surveyor at Chittagong will be pleased to inform you of the detailed requirements of an Annual Classification Survey, if desired.
