Motorship "TIRTONADI"

(S) I have to acknowledge receipt of your reports 8 & 9 No.5548 in respect of this vessel's drydocking and machinery survey carried out at your port in November.

It would appear however that no reply has yet been received to my letter of the 23rd October and reminder of the 29th November, 1958. I shall therefore be glad if you will make arrangements with Mr. McGinness for the First Entry report which was enclosed with my letter of the 23rd October to be completed and forwarded to this Office at an early date.

At the same time I shall be glad if you will forward the necessary approved plans showing modifications (if any) which were carried out during construction of the above ship together with "As Built" plans and forging and casting Certificates for the rudder and stern frame etc..

It was stated on page 4 of the First Entry report that plans of cross sections, bulkheads and general arrangement had been attached to the report. As these plans do not appear to have been received I shall be glad if you will also arrange for them to accompany the above documents.

Assignment of class to this vessel is being withheld pending receipt of the new First Entry report and the necessary plans referred to above.
