We thank you for your letter of the 3rd inst., with regards to the above vessel, and note the unfortunate casualty incurred by the vessel when grounding off Tsushima Island on July 13th 1962.

As you are aware from our previous correspondence that the Committee of Lloyd's Register have agreed to maintain the vessel's Class until the vessel drydocks on or about the 5th of August, it is regretted to learn from your letter that it is your intention to withdraw the vessel from Class particularly as the vessel is now under repair at the Dae Sun Shipbuilding Co.

Our Acting Surveyor at Pusan Mr. Shin is always available to carry out surveys on behalf of the Society's clients and it is hoped therefore you may utilise his services and retain the vessel as at present classed.

Your remarks about the "GUMRYONG" have also been noted and we therefore await your further advices in due course.
