Noted during survey, that at some time previously, forward hatches Port and Starboard & after hatch starboard have been removed and plated over, also middle hatches Port and Starboard have been converted into companion ways. Companion ways are strongly constructed of steel with wood doors 5'-6" x 2'-0" capable of being manipulated from both sides, height of sill - 18", openings in deck are 4'-6" x 2'-9". All hatches mentioned above are on Poop Deck.
