Dumb Barges "UNITED NINE - TWENTY"

I acknowledge your reports Nos. 604/9 regarding the General Examination of the barges "UNITED NINE - FOURTEEN" but before these and the remaining cases receive the consideration of the Committee, it will be necessary for the position regarding the equipment to be clarified.

Prior to forwarding the First Entry Reports on these barges, the Karachi Surveyor stated in a letter dated the 14th January 1964 that the Builders were supplying equipment to Rule requirements, but no information has been received that a stream anchor, stream wire and towline were fitted to complete the equipment.

I shall be glad, therefore, if you will state whether these items of equipment are, in fact, fitted on board and, if not, what the Owners intentions are in this respect.
