I acknowledge your memorandum of the 20th September and note your comments regarding the completion of the Special Survey.

If the Special Survey is not completed at your port about the end of the present month, you should inform me at an early date as to the Owners' proposals for dealing with the ~~thin~~ ^{thin} shell and deck plates revealed at the part Special Survey held in March 1965, referred to in my Classing Letter dated the 19th July.

With regard to the Continuous Survey cycle of the machinery, if the cycle is not completed at your port about the end of the present month, a General Examination of the machinery will require to be held and the cycle advanced by the examination of the following long overdue items not seen for six/seven years:-


All main engine journals and main bearings
Main engine fuel injection pumps
Engine tested working and manoeuvring
Starboard aft auxiliary engine
