

Steel Motor Ship, Messrs. Goole S.B. & R. Co's No. 357,

"EMPIRE CLIFF"

Dimensions:- 190' x 30' x 13.5'

Class:- 100A1

This vessel is stated to be a duplicate of the same Builders' No. 329, the "SEQUACITY". The only point that arises from the correspondence is that it was pointed out in a letter dated 2nd February, 1940, that the floor plates in the double bottom should be .28 in thickness, and not .26 as indicated on the oil fuel bunker plan, but the bottom shell plating at the ends could be .33 in thickness.
