Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the question of the fees for the survey of the electrical installation of the motorship "EMPIRE CLIFF", referred to in your letter of the 21st instant, has been under consideration, and in reply I have to say that the equipment appears to be quite normal and no reason is seen why the Rule fees should not apply, as in the case of the sister ship "SEQUACITY".

It is noted the generator tests were witnessed by the Bristol Surveyors, but it is not known why this was done as it is not a requirement of classification neither would it be considered necessary were the Society carrying out the specification survey.

The Rule fee of £24 - 5 - 0 should therefore be charged, plus the fee for the specification.
