
With reference to your letter of the 7th instant, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Greenock, regarding the motor vessel "POWELL", Messrs. Lithgows Ltd. Yard No. 1046, I beg to acquaint you that Greenock F.E. Reports No. 24249 were submitted to the Scottish Sub-Committee of Classification at their Meeting today, when the vessel was classed subject to a doubling plate being fitted on upper deck in poop in way of access opening to separator gastight space at the earliest opportunity.
