


## LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING

Port FALMOUTH.Date 3rd November, 1962.**This is to Certify** *that I have*

surveyed the m.s. "LUCERNA" 11,292. Gross tons of Liverpool whilst afloat and in drydock at Falmouth on the 22nd October, 1962 and subsequently on account of damages stated to have been sustained by:-

- (1) Contact with dock wall when leaving Falmouth 16.5.61.
- (2) Contact with dock wall when entering drydock at Falmouth 22.10.61.
- (3) Touching bottom when proceeding down river after leaving Abadan 30.6.62.
- (4) Heavy weather on various dates between April and September 1962.
- (5) Cause and date unknown.

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be continued as classed and to have fresh record of drydocking 10,62 subject to set up bottom shell plates A.4 (ps from a) and A.4 (ps from fwd) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking, and without condition concerning set in vertical shell plate etc. No.9 (ss from a).
