
In reply to your letter of the 21st April, I am pleased to inform you that provided a satisfactory General Examination is held in dry dock shortly, the Committee will then be prepared to consider the postponement of the Special Survey until some time before the end of June, 1965. The Continuous Survey of the machinery should be completed at the drydocking or, alternatively, a General Examination of the machinery be held and the Continuous Survey cycle advanced including the examination of main engine No. 5 crankshaft journal and bearing, and the crankcase explosion relief devices. I note that drydocking will take place in Greece.
