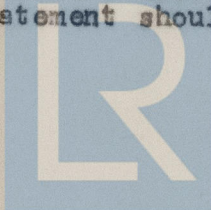

19748. "LUCERNA". This vessel has today been classed ~~1100A~~.1. "Carrying petroleum in bulk" together with the appropriate notations as recommended by you.

I shall be glad if you will confirm the following items:-

1. The intercostal side girder in double bottom aft is .44 in thickness,
2. The rivets in shell seam "C" to "D" are 1" diameter spaced 4" apart,
3. The length of the bridge is 50',
4. The depth of the floors in the deep tank is 48".

It is concluded that this vessel is a Sister ship to the "ATLANTIC DUKE", and if so, this statement should have been contained in your report.
