Fee for Auxiliary Electrical Equipment

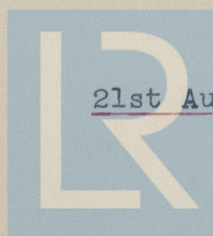
Total capacity of generators - 17.1 kw
Fee as per scale for survey during construction and installation on board - £17.

At the request of the Shipbuilders the two generators, although of under 100 kw, were manufactured under the Society's survey and the Manchester Surveyors charged a fee of £4 4s. 0d.

On completion of the ship, the Hull Surveyors charged the full scale fee. The Shipbuilders have raised objection to this and they maintain that credit should be given for the charge made to the generator manufacturers in respect of the survey during construction.

The Hull Surveyors ask for a ruling in the matter and point out that in such cases it has always been their practice to charge the full fee where the generators are of under 100 kw and are consequently not required by the Rules to be built under Survey.

SUBMITTED the Surveyors be advised that they are quite in order in debiting the Shipbuilders with the full scale fee in such cases. They should inform Messrs. Richard Dunston Limited, that the published scale for the survey of auxiliary electrical equipment covers the work required in accordance with the Society's Rules. The generators in this case are not required to be inspected by the Society's Surveyors during construction at the Maker's works and the request for such inspection must be regarded as being additional to classification requirements, for which an appropriate fee is chargeable.
