Plans of poop and bridge should also be forwarded for verification of particulars given in their report and also for record purposes.

A capacity plan should also be furnished as the information given in the report is insufficient for full particulars of tanks to be recorded in the Register Book.

The surveyors should also state if Nos tanks P.S. & C. are fitted for the carriage of water ballast only. This has been done on similar ships for the same Owners built at other shipyards.
