Class Withdrawn

Your letter of the 3rd instant with your previous communication of 22nd October have again been fully discussed by the Committee here, and in reply I am asked to say that they see no reason to modify their procedure which for many years has satisfied the readers of the Register Book.

As previously explained, the practice, when correctly applied, reflects the facts at the time of actual withdrawal from Lloyd's Register, *and* that the entry of another Society's name indicates that the ship has since been surveyed to the satisfaction of that Society.

In the case of the "ELPIS", following your letter of the 17th instant, a note will appear in our December Supplement that the ship is now classed with the Bureau Veritas.
