The Glasgow Office have telephoned to say that this ship is at their port and that she is being transferred to Liberian flag at this time.

It appears that a request for attendance on board was received from Messrs. Denholms (local Agents) but on further investigation the Agents state that they understand that the loadline is to be dealt with by Bureau Veritas.

The Glasgow Office request that we investigate the matter urgently and, if necessary, with the London Agents, Messrs. Pegasus Ocean Services.

I have telephoned Pegasus (ROY 8421) who state that class is being transferred to Bureau Veritas which Society will also take care of the Loadline, Safety etc. and transfer to Liberian registration.

Pegasus will now write officially stating that class etc. is being transferred to Bureau Veritas and, in the meantime, they state that we should instruct our Surveyors in Glasgow to take no action in this case. I have telephoned Glasgow to this effect.
