Steamer "BELLATRIX".

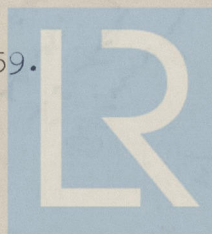
The Special Survey became due in 2/58 and was commenced in June, 1958 (Hamburg Report No. 6726). Subsequently the Owners made application for an extension of class, see our telex No. 422. This application did not receive the Committee's approval and the vessel was laid up at Hamburg.

At the request of the Owners a Senior Surveyor visited the ship whilst laid up and discussed with the Superintendent the outstanding items remaining to be examined together with previous recommended repairs for completion of Special Survey. At that time the need for adequate scaling of certain tanks and spaces was particularly stressed.

On the 10th March and the 27th May the same Surveyor again attended at the request of the Owners for examination of certain spaces. On each occasion no attempt had been made to have these spaces properly prepared for survey and the Surveyor was unable to make specific recommendations.

The ship has recently been placed in the hands of Messrs. H.C. Stülcken Sohn and the survey has been in progress at the repair yard since the 22nd July, and an examination of tanks and spaces submitted to-date has revealed the necessity for considerable repairs.
