I duly received Mr. Morrison's letter of the 10th instant submitting for the consideration of the Committee a Plan of the Main Boiler fitted in the Tug "M. MORAM", which Vessel the new Owners desire to have Classed with this Society, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that provided 10 additional stay tubes not less than $\frac{1}{4}$ inch thick be fitted where shewn on the Plan and the Boiler on examination be found in a good and safe working condition the same will be approved for a working pressure of 150 lbs per square inch.


