A letter has been received from the Southampton Surveyors enclosing a plan of the boiler fitted in this vessel and stating that the new Owners desire to have the vessel classed with this Society.

The Surveyors also state that the thickness of the boiler plates have been found in agreement with the plan.

It is submitted that provided 10 additional stay tubes not less than $\frac{1}{4}$ inch thick be fitted where shewn on the plan and the boiler on examination be found in a good and safe working condition the same might be approved for a working pressure of 150 lbs per square inch.

Further provided the machinery be opened out and on examination be found in good condition and fitted in accordance with the requirements of the Rules a record of LMC with date but without the distinguishing mark might be assigned.
