The shell has been drilled and the thicknesses are as given on the Midship Section.

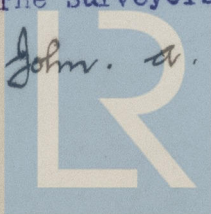
The ship has been built in America and entered in the Register Book.
