Remarks On the 12th ultimo the Genoa Surveyors reported that the vessel had been sold and that the new Owners had stated that the vessel was laid up at La Spezia and that they had not decided whether the vessel would be placed in commission again or broken up. The case received the consideration of the Committee on the 20th ultimo, as a result of which the Genoa Surveyors were informed that the Committee were not prepared to allow the vessel's class to remain undisturbed for an undefined period, and, should the Owner not be able to furnish a fairly definite proposal with regard to her future, ~~the~~ particularly to her survey arrangements, they would have no alternative but to deal with her class.
