 accordance with the requirements of the Society's Rules, approved plans, the  
 Secretary's letters and to our satisfaction and that we are recommending that the  
 machinery of this vessel be now eligible to have the record of LLOYD'S MACHINERY  
 CERTIFICATE (LMC) 6.62 and TAIL SHAFT SURVEY (TSb) 6.62 subject to the torsional  
 vibration characteristics of the dynamic system being approved and, after the  
 vessel has been unloaded in Burma the machinery installation to be submitted  
 for a General Examination and dock trials witnessed in order to ascertain
