I have to acknowledge receipt of your memorandum of the 7th instant, and to inform you in reply that the screwshaft when the ship was built is stated to have been fitted with a continuous liner, and the sternbush fitted also with an approved type of oil gland.

I have to refer to your report No.2494 in which you state that the shaft is fitted with a continuous liner, and that an approved oil gland is fitted. If the screwshaft now fitted has not got a continuous liner, the shaft would appear to have been changed, but not reported upon, and I shall be glad to receive your comments.
