REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Annual Survey and Overhaul, the vessel being placed on the Wellington Patent Slip, Evans Bay, on 5th November, 1934, and thoroughly scrubbed down for this purpose.

HULL (OUTSIDE): Examined and found in good condition; all the previous pitting has been effectively checked by the white zinc and gold size and the standard barge and hulk anti-fouling composition used in this harbour (coal tar thinned with kerosene) has now been applied.

RUDDER: Examined and found in good condition.
