Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 13th instant respecting the Tug "NO.624", the contents of which are noted.

It would appear that the vessel regarding which Messrs. Compagnie Delmas-Vieljeux have now furnished particulars is not the Tug which has been the subject of our previous correspondence, but is a wooden vessel whose particulars do not appear in the Register Book.

In all the circumstances and in view of the difficulty which is being experienced in tracing the Ownership of the Tugs "NO.624" to "NO.633", "NO.658", "NO.658" and "NO.743" it is proposed to omit these vessels from the next reprint of the Register Book, but, before giving instructions to this effect, I shall be glad if you will furnish me with your views on this suggestion.
