I duly received your letter of the 22nd of March respecting the 13 tugs "No.624" to No.633" and "No.656", No.658" and "No.743".

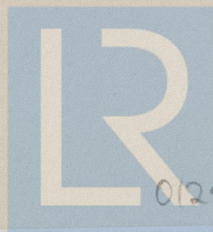
