H. You will observe that 13 Tugs, "NO.624" to "NO.633" and "NO.656", "NO.658" and "NO.743" (Nos.20612 to 20624 in the current Register Book) are shown as owned by the French Government but do not appear to have been submitted to survey since building.

In each case the Intermediate Survey of the oil engines, prescribed by the Rules of the British Corporation, is due and in the circumstances it will be appreciated if you will kindly endeavour to ascertain whether these vessels are still the property of the French Government and whether it is intended to maintain their classification.
