Dated: 14th July 1959.

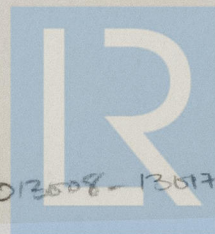
The m.v. "TANDJUNG RAYA" is now in dry-dock and programmed to complete the Classification Survey within the next week or two. The Reports C11 and C11 (Comp.) have just been completed and forwarded to you for the assignment of Freeboards.

The Classification Survey of the m.v. "TANDJUNG TORAWITAN" is also well advanced and this vessel will very shortly be dry-docking for Freeboard measuring etc;

Other vessels are undergoing periodical Surveys at Tandjong Priok.

Both the "TANDJUNG" Ships are Government owned and managed by the Government P.E.L.N.I. Company, if these ships are delayed or sail with the Classification Surveys incomplete due to there being no Lloyd's Surveyor at Djakarta, it may quite well re-act unfavourably on the possible LR Classification of future new construction (please see your cable 26th March 1959, relating to continuance of Society in Indonesia.)
