Motorship "KOSEI MARU"  
Refrigerated Cargo Installation.

Reverting to the Secretary's letter dated 19th July last, I would advise you that the Shimonoseki Surveyors have forwarded their report on the Special Survey of the refrigerating machinery of this ship during construction.

As a result of this survey a record of Lloyd's RMC 7,57 "to maintain temperature 0°F with sea temperature 20°F maximum" has been assigned.

It is noted from the Shimonoseki Surveyors' report that a test was carried out in accordance with the old Rules between 15th and 17th July, 1957. This test has been accepted in this case, but in future tests must be carried out in accordance with Section N 5 of the Rules, and I shall be glad if you will advise all ports in Japan accordingly.
