Steamer "PINNACLES"

This ship is overdue for Special, Screwshaft and Main Boiler Surveys and as she has been laid up at Baltimore, the Committee have deferred action on the understanding that the surveys will receive attention before she proceeds to sea.

On the 5th instant it was observed from the Shipping Papers that the vessel had been towed to Emden and the New York office was requested to furnish further information regarding the classification of this ship.
