It is noted from your Report No. 11651, that the Owners representative requested that no record of Docking Survey be assigned, and while, of course, this is quite in order, from our point of view it would be interesting to know the reason for this request, as it is customary for a Docking date to be assigned in all instances when a vessel is examined in drydock.

The Docking date does not, of course, signify that an Annual Survey has been held, and therefore not necessarily that the bottom has been recoated.

Paragraph B. 801 of the Rules states that the date of the last examination in drydock, or on a slipway, will be recorded in the Supplement to the Register Book.
