"TAI PING YANG" - I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 9th October, the contents of which have been noted and the class has been continued subject to the auxiliary condenser not being used until surveyed. I shall, therefore, be glad if you will advise the Owners accordingly.

561, "ESSO 5" - As recommended. It is concluded that the hatches and closing appliances were found in good condition although not reported, but please confirm this.

In view of the satisfactory nature of the General Examination now held, the Committee have agreed to postponement of the Special Survey until January, 1962, and I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.

R.4" - Reverting to my letter of the 14th March enclosing a copy of a list of items which was forwarded to the Owners regarding the Continuous Survey, I have to point out that the port aft auxiliary engine was quoted in error as being outstanding for survey, and the machine which should have been mentioned was the port forward auxiliary engine.

Although a notation of CS 9.61 has now been assigned, I shall be glad if you will ask the Owners if they will make arrangements for the port forward engine to be examined at their earliest convenience.
