This ship has been under survey at Oslo

on 27th June 1957 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/found:—

1. The access hatches forward and aft to stores having notices stating that the covers are to be kept closed and secured while the ship is at sea. ✓
2. The hatch to steering gear having a 24" coaming. ✓
3. Permanent chain attachment fitted to covers of both the screw type flush scuttles. ✓
4. The five air pipes on the fore deck increased to a height of 36" measured to the opening, and to the four air pipes aft fitted with shifting holes. ✓
5. The side scuttles to steering gear compartment are of substantial construction. ✓
6. Lifelines fitted fore and aft. ✓
